Project Experience

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- **Conducted over 200 EHS compliance audits, environmental site assessments, and reviews, and risk assessments (averaging approximately 6-10 assessments per year).** Industries include, among others: waste/wastewater disposal and processing facilities, construction and remediation, chemical processing, lead-acid battery manufacturing, food and consumer goods processing, metals and machining, equipment manufacturing and/or assembly, corrosion-resistant coatings application, and coal-fired and oil-fired power plant operations.
- **Evaluated sustainability program elements for various industrial and consumer goods clients. Provided recommendations to increase sustainable actions.** Activities included: conducted a multinational interview program to ascertain a baseline of needs and activities related to sustainability and risk; conducted site level evaluations related to program implementation and levels of risk; recommended actionable items to reduce regulatory burden, pollution and waste generation, and environmental risk.
- **Prepared more than fifteen environmental permit applications for various manufacturing plants.** Applications included those for new facilities/operations, modification of existing permits, and renewal of existing permits. Topics included: air emissions, water withdrawal and wastewater discharge, and stormwater discharge, among others.
- **Identified environmental permit requirements for various manufacturing and power clients in PA, DE and NJ.** Worked as a team with new facility developers to evaluate the federal and state regulatory requirements associated with chemical storage, air emissions, water discharge, and waste generation. In each case, created a permit matrix that included the permit required, the timeframe to submit applications, the regulatory applicability to the operation, and in some cases anticipated costs.
- **Conducted risk management program audits at various waste treatment, wastewater treatment and disposal facilities to identify compliance risks for waste generators.** Facility types included hazardous and municipal waste landfills, hazardous waste transfer facilities, wastewater treatment facilities, and metals recycling facilities.

Audit topics covered included EHS compliance such as waste approval process; air emissions, water handling and discharge, and waste permits; monitoring and reporting; residuals management; incident or release history; historic and present remedial actions; facility design, including liner construction and maintenance; and community relations.
- **Managed regulated wastes for a variety of industrial sectors including hazardous wastes, universal wastes, TSCA wastes and Pennsylvania regulated residual wastes.** Activities included: proper waste determination (including identifying regulatory exemptions where applicable),

evaluating and upgrading container management techniques, training, conducting inspections, identifying proper disposal options, developing written waste management manuals/SOPs, annual reporting and recordkeeping, and identifying waste minimization opportunities.

- **Partnered with a variety of managers to develop written programs, policies, and procedures to meet regulatory, stakeholder, or company requirements.** Topics included: zero waste to landfill, managing hazardous materials, contractor management, and various regulatory EHS policies and procedures (e.g., hazard communications, emissions reporting, and hazardous waste contingency planning). The specificity of the written programs ranged from corporate overview of general requirements to site-specific and equipment specific operating procedures.
- **Provided routine on-site EHS support for more than 20 years at various industrial facilities.** Environmental programs included: hazardous waste management and disposal, PCB and asbestos management and disposal; permit required data collection and reporting; inspections; permit applications, amendments, and renewals; disposal vendor qualification evaluation; and agency correspondence and notifications.

Safety programs included: hazard communications, industrial hygiene monitoring, written procedures and

employee training, program gap assessment/audits, and personal protective equipment hazard assessments.

- **Supported regulatory efforts for industrial clients extracting natural gas from the Marcellus Shale formation.** Activities included: developing written policies and procedures to ensure compliance with state-specific EHS regulatory requirements; identifying applicable regulatory requirements for drilling locations, developing drilling pads, and producing gas; recommending proper waste handling within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and developing a risk survey for drilling and pipeline locations.
- **Prepared more than 50 environmental management plans** including storm water pollution prevention plans, spill prevention control and countermeasures plans, integrated contingency plans, quality assurance/quality control plans, and RCRA contingency plans for a variety of industrial manufacturing facilities.
